



ACE SUPPORTS the following proposed legislation:

S. 1239 – Would extend the RVP waiver to fuel blends containing gasoline and ten percent or more ethanol.

Sponsors: Senator Joe Donnelly (D-IN) **Co-Sponsors:** 16

H.R. 1736 – Would extend the RVP waiver to fuel blends containing gasoline and ten percent or more ethanol.

Sponsor: Congressman Adrian Smith (R-NE03) **Co-Sponsors:** 40

ACE OPPOSES the following proposed legislation:

S. 577 – Corn Ethanol Mandate Elimination Act of 2015

Amends the Clean Air Act to eliminate the volume standards under the renewable fuel program applicable to conventional biofuel.

Sponsors: Senators Pat Toomey (R-PA), Dianne Feinstein (D-CA), Jeff Flake (R-AZ), Susan Collins (R-ME)

S. 791 – American Energy Renaissance Act of 2015

Would phase out the RFS over five years.

Sponsor: Senator Ted Cruz (R-TX) **Co-Sponsors:** None

S. 934 – The Phantom Fuel Reform Act

Would change the methodology used to set the cellulosic biofuel volumes of the RFS.

Sponsors: Senators Jeff Flake (R-AZ) and Mike Crapo (R-ID)

H.R. 21 - Would reverse EPA's approval of E15 and require more unnecessary testing for higher ethanol blends.

Sponsor: Congressman James Sensenbrenner (R-WI05) **Co-Sponsors:** 14

H.R. 434 – LEVEL Act (Leave Ethanol Volumes at Existing Levels Act)
Would repeal Renewable Fuel Standard II, keeping RFS I volumes intact.

Sponsor: Congressman Michael Burgess (R-TX26). **Co-Sponsors:** None

H.R. 703 – Renewable Fuel Standard Elimination Act
Repeals the Renewable Fuel Standard.

Sponsor: Congressman Bob Goodlatte (R-VA06). **Co-Sponsors:** 82

H.R. 704 – RFS Reform Act of 2015
Prohibits corn starch from qualifying as conventional biofuel, decreases advanced and cellulosic volumes, and reverses EPA's approval of E15.

Sponsor: Congressman Bob Goodlatte (R-VA06). **Co-Sponsors:** 59
