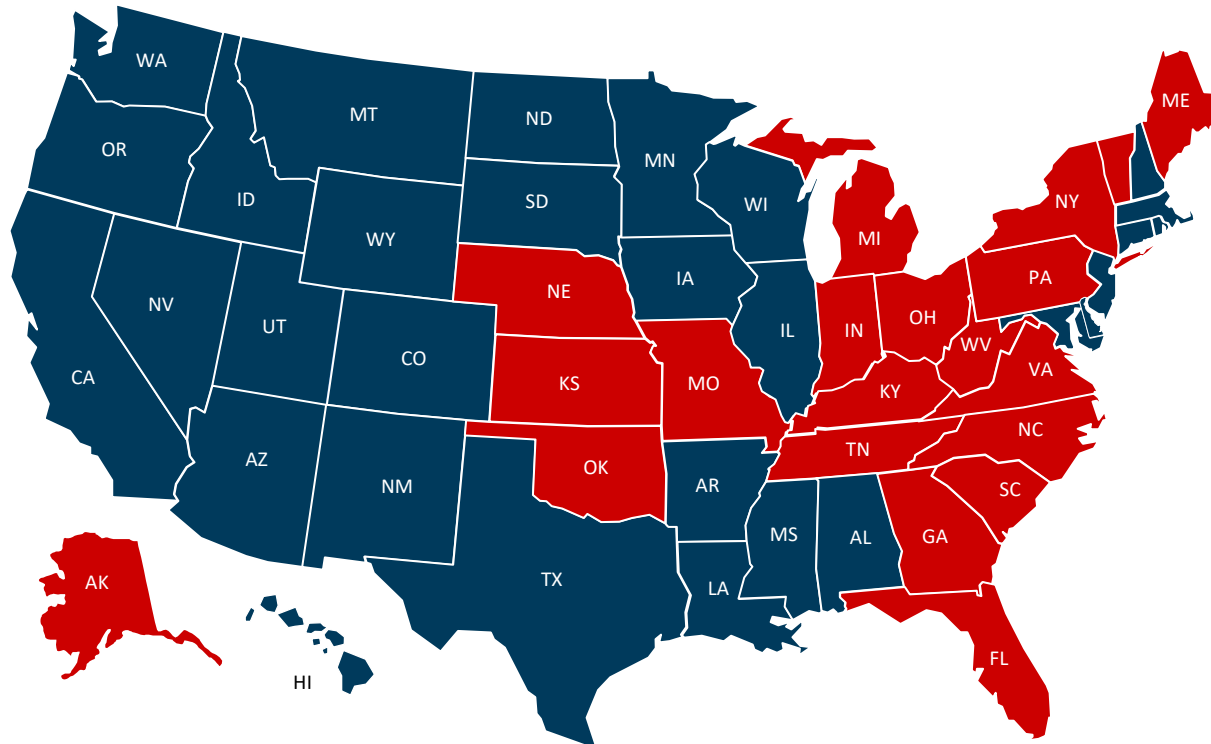


31 STATES ALREADY USE MORE THAN 10% ETHANOL
