H.R. 104 – LEVEL Act (Leave Ethanol Volumes at Existing Levels Act)

Sponsor: Congressman Michael Burgess (R-TX-26) **Co-Sponsors:** 0

Would repeal Renewable Fuel Standard II, keeping RFS I volumes intact.



H.R. 1024 – Consumer Protection and Fuel Transparency Act of 2019

Sponsor: Congressman Austin Scott (R-GA-8) **Co-Sponsors:** 5

A bill to require the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to revise labeling requirements for fuel pumps that dispense E15. Labels for E15 would be required to include the word "WARNING," the words "check your manual," be 5"x7" or larger, include indicators with respect to vehicles, engines, and equipment prohibited from using E15 (including pictograms depicting a boat, lawnmower, chainsaw, motorcycle, and snowmobile and include warnings with respect to pre-2001 model year vehicles). The law would also require additional labeling for blender pumps, warning consumers of residual gasoline left in gasoline pump hoses from previous dispensing.
